

What does the "Reproductive Freedom" Ballot Question mean?

*Zero accountability for gross negligence or medical malpractice.

Abortion at any gestational age. Minors receiving abortions without parental consent.

No limits on anything related to reproductive freedom

Should the Constitution of Virginia be amended to (i) protect the **freedom** to make personal decisions about prenatal care, childbirth, postpartum care, birth control, **abortion**, miscarriage management, and **fertility** care; (ii) **protect** doctors, nurses, and **patients** from being punished for these decisions; and (iii) **allow for** **restrictions** on access to abortion during the **third trimester** of pregnancy except when the patient's health is at risk or the pregnancy cannot survive?"

Zero oversight with safety inspections at abortion facilities. Abortionists practicing without proper licensing and training. Abandoned or ignored malpractice claims.

Implies potential sale of IVF embryos and surrogacy without limits.

Abortion regulations are only enforced if not perceived as "restrictive" or impeding reproductive access.
